

Bug Bingo – caller sheet PAs 2020

Ask players to cross the answers to each question out on their Bingo sheet. The questions are read out by the tutor *in the order below*. The first person to line up 5 correct answers (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) is the winner. The point at which this is first possible is highlighted in the list of questions. Prizes are a good addition but difficult if playing remotely!

1. This organism is the cause of bacterial tonsillitis and necrotising fasciitis
2. These organisms live in the bowel and cannot survive if there is too much oxygen
3. Gentamicin is toxic to the kidneys, what other unwanted effect is important?
4. This is a test used to visualise virus particles
5. This is what a Gram stain of *Staphylococcus* would look like
6. This antibiotic group is reserved for critically ill patients
7. This organism causes pseudomembranous colitis
8. This test is how we distinguish *S. aureus* from other staphylococci
9. This is a test for antibodies or antigens
10. This organism lives in the bowel and also commonly causes urinary infection
11. This organism live sin the environment and is inherently very resistant to many antibiotics
12. This antibiotic is used exclusively for staphylococcal infections
13. This is what you might see in the blood culture of someone with *Klebsiella* sepsis
14. When this is methicillin resistant it is much more difficult to treat

First line of 5 possible – diagonal line from top left

For those who don't have a line, carry on:

15. This is what *Neisseria meningitidis* looks like on microscopy
16. This test detects nucleic acids (DNA or RNA)
17. This drug is used to treat bacterial tonsillitis

Second line of 5 possible - vertical far right

18. This is an antimicrobial stewardship initiative

Third line of 5 – vertical, second from far right

19. This is the mechanism of action of beta-lactam antibiotics
20. A way of determining whether a rash is purpuric

4th line of 5 – horizontal, bottom line

21. App you can download with your Health Board antibiotic policy on it

5th line of 5 – horizontal, second from top
